


Attendance Update






Christmas Plate Competition

With winter definitely upon us, below is a reminder of our policy. The school entrances will be gritted as well as a pathway leading from each gate to the school entrances and one path from the school gates to the children's entrances. Can you please ensure that the footpaths are used to travel between the school entrances and the classrooms.

We will also try to keep parents informed using the school text messaging service and Class dojo. Please make sure that you have a Class Dojo login and that school has your current telephone contact. A decision will be made daily as to whether our playground is suitable for use by the children at breaktime and lunchtime. It may be necessary to have indoor playtimes and dinnertimes if we feel that there is a risk to the children's safety.
