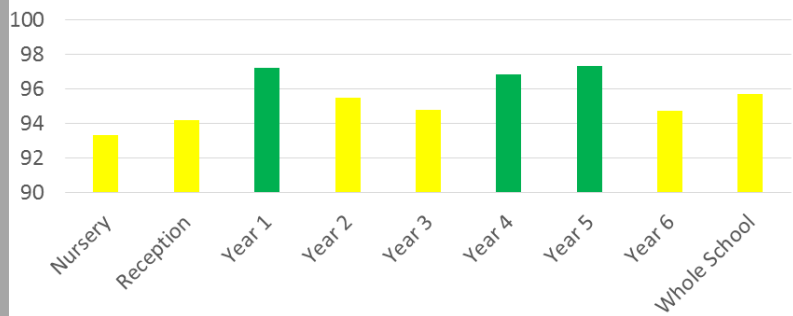
Learning with God and Each Other to Be the Best We Can Be

Attendance

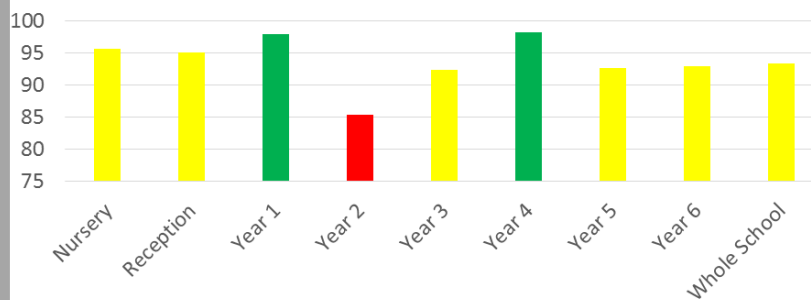

Autumn 2015 and Spring 2016 Attendance

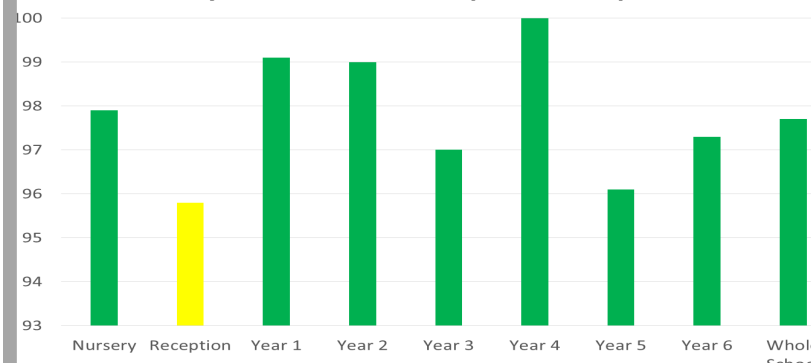


We have 14 weeks to try and achieve our 96.5% target and the goal of having all classes in school green.

Weekly Attendance: 18th - 24th March 2016



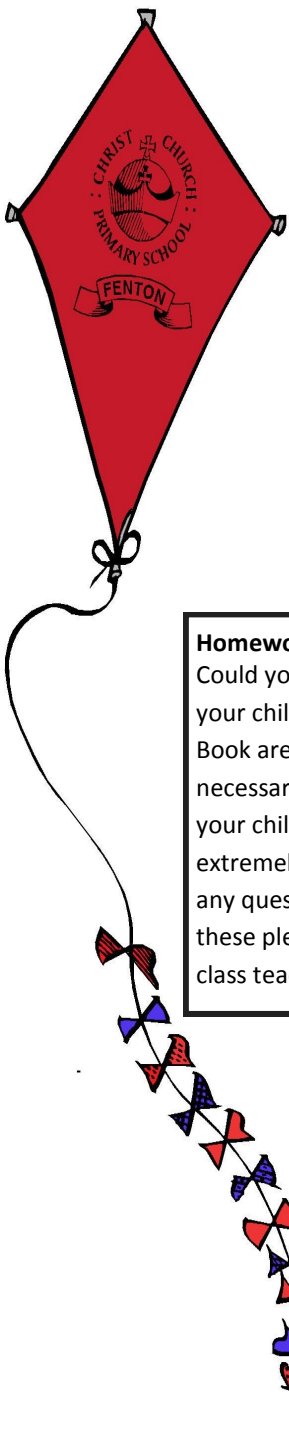
Weekly Attendance: 11th April - 14th April 2016
