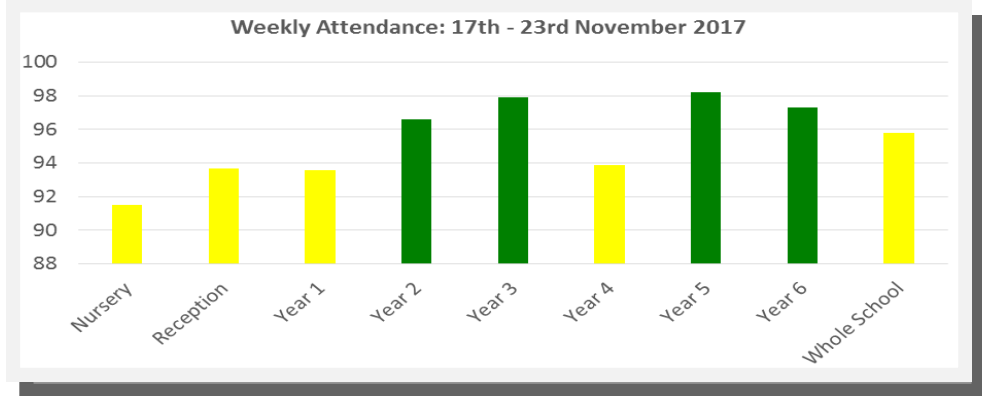

Well done to the children below who were our October Attendance Prize Draw Winners.

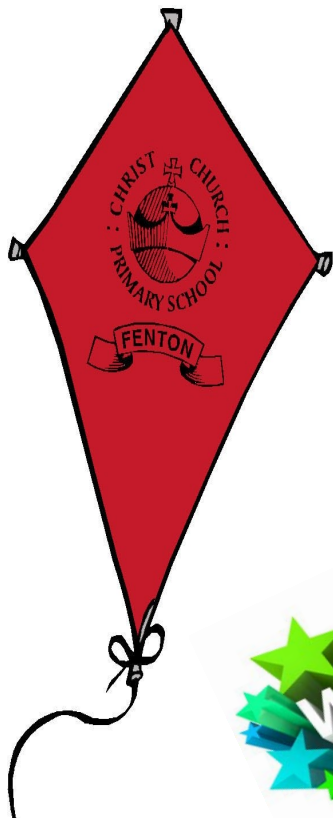
