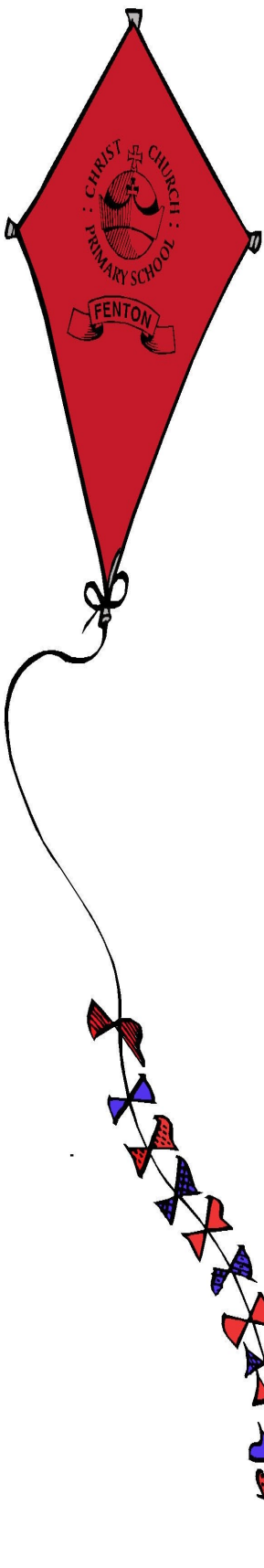

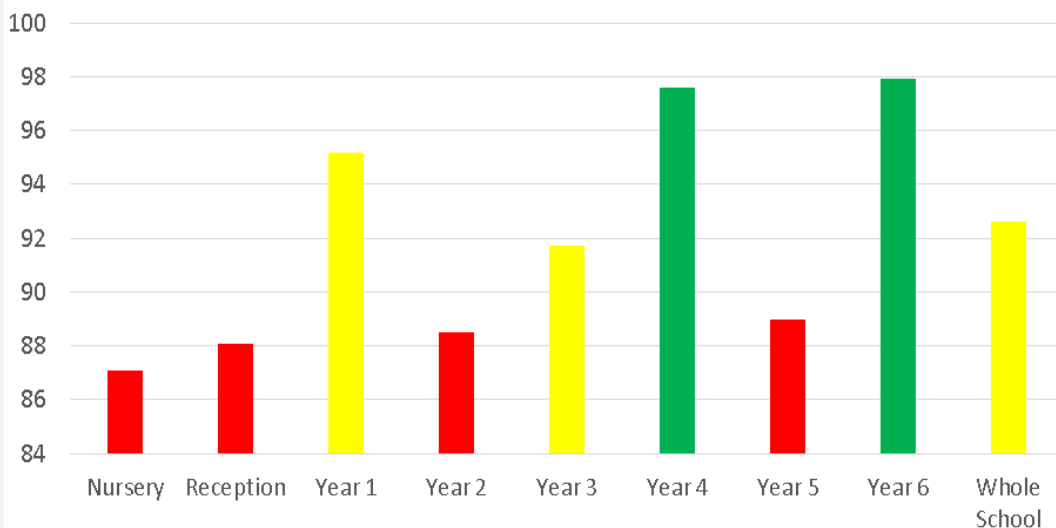

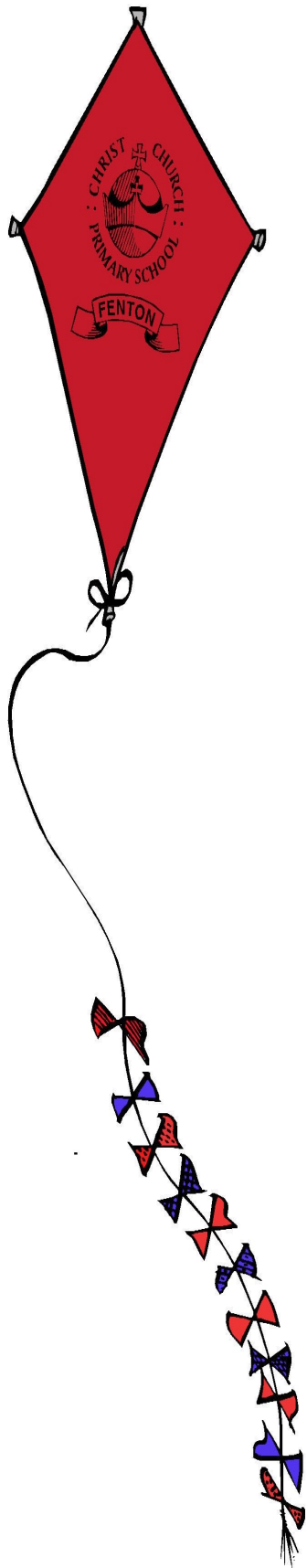
We wish all of our Year Leavers’ the very best for the future. You will all be missed!

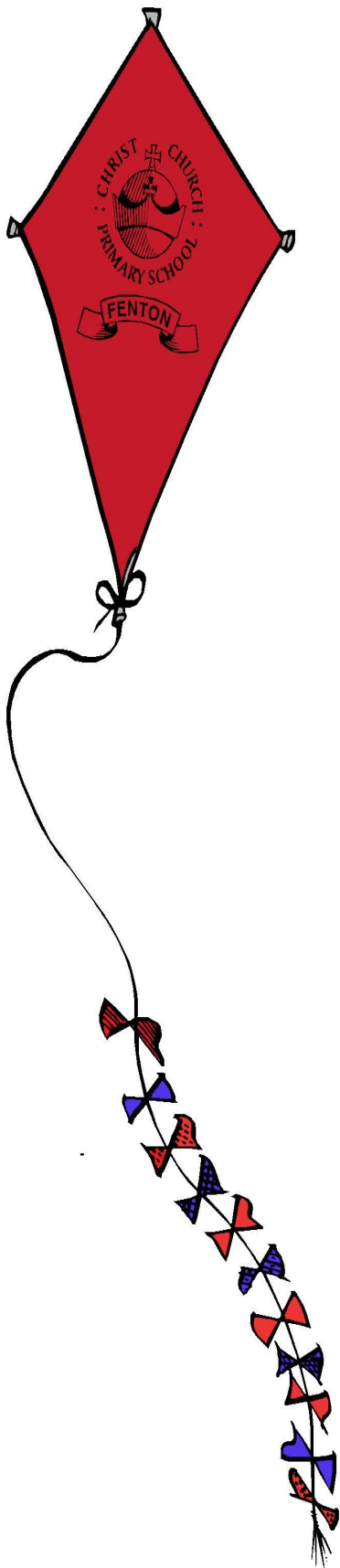
School Uniform

As you will probably need to buy some new school uniform for your child during the summer holidays, here is a brief reminder:

- ◆ All children need to wear sensible black shoes - **trainers are not allowed.**
- ◆ For the boys grey shorts or trousers.
- ◆ For the girls grey skirts, trousers, shorts or a gingham dress in warmer weather.
- ◆ A white polo shirt with a school sweatshirt or red v-neck jumper.
- ◆ School fleeces are not allowed to be worn in the classroom.
- ◆ Long hair needs to be tied back.
- ◆ **Earrings, necklaces and bracelets are not allowed** but it is okay to wear a watch.
- ◆ **We do not allow tramlines shaved into hair.**
- ◆ Make-up, including nail varnish and temporary tattoos (except after school discos and other events), is not allowed.

The best time to have ears pierced is at the beginning of the summer holidays so that it does not prevent children from taking part in P.E. and swimming lessons which are essential parts of the national curriculum. This is also the best time to have tramlines shaved into hair so that they have grown out before returning to school.

We will contact you if your child does not comply with our school uniform policy.
