

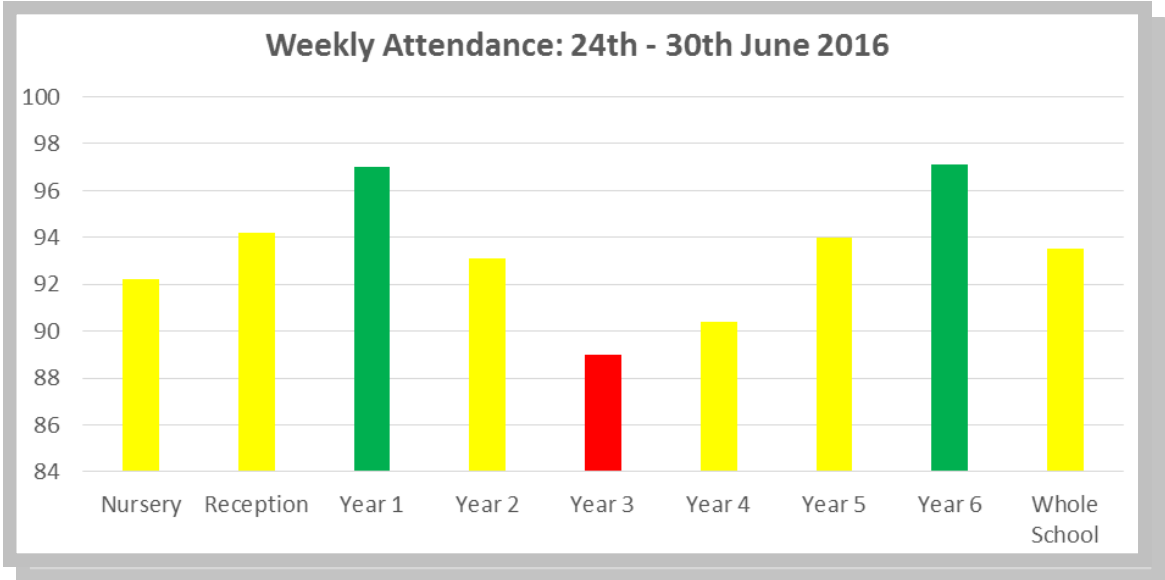

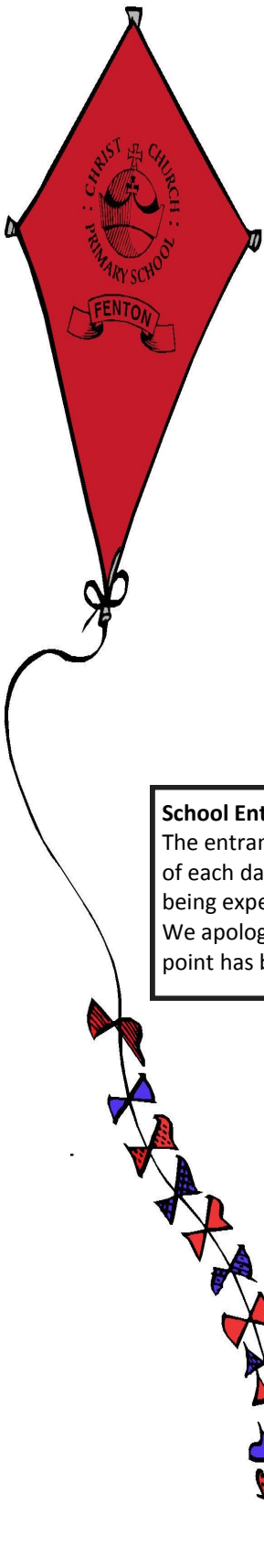

Bicycles and Scooters on the Playground

Another reminder that children should not be riding their bicycles or scooters on the school playground before or after school. Ofsted

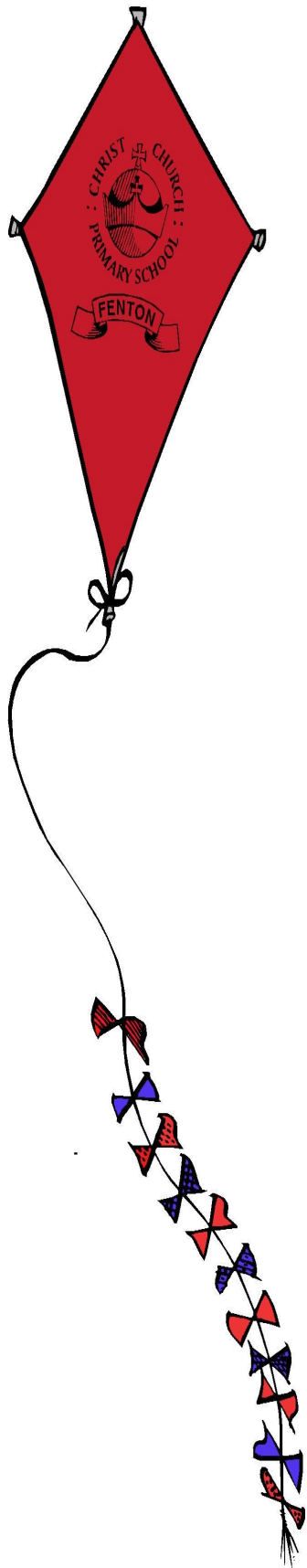
