


# CHRIST CHURCH PRIMARY ACADEMY NEWS

#### **Modeshift Stars Award**

As part of our PHSE curriculum, children have been learning all about keeping safe on the roads. In Nursery and Reception, children have been taught how important it is to hold hands near busy roads. This week, children will be learning about the importance of having the correct car seat and wearing seatbelts when travelling in a car. We have put a guide up in reception which can be used to measure your child and check which car seat they should be using. If you would like to check which car seat your child should be using, just buzz in to reception and they will let you in.

Friday 11<sup>th</sup> March - Gift sets, toiletries, chocolate and anything that could be a Mothering Sunday gift


Friday 18<sup>th</sup> March - Wrapping Paper and Gift Bags
