Our PE and Sport Premium allocation for the academic year 2017/2018 is estimated to be £15, 857.

It is our aim to ensure that the PE and Sport Premium funding has a positive impact upon the health and well-being of our pupils as well as being able to provide a variety of sporting activities for all pupils.

This money will be spent on:

- Funding membership of oPEn – a Primary PE School Sport Partnership which provides opportunities for children to participate in competitive sports and staff to take part in PE professional development;
- Improving our outdoor playground facilities for use during PE lessons;
- Providing after school clubs for children to improve their health and well-being;
- Purchasing a scheme of work for KS1 and KS2 to ensure that the PE curriculum is being delivered effectively;
- Funding swimming lessons for all key stage 2 pupils.

As a result of the funding:

- There will be increased opportunities for children to take part in competitive sports;
- We will be much better equipped to teach PE/Games to all classes;
- All of our key stage 2 children will receive a course of 10 swimming lessons which should impact upon the percentage achieving the national expectation of being able to swim at least 25 metres.

Sustainability

- Membership of oPEn provides staff with regular CPD which is utilised to help improve the quality of teaching and learning in PE;
- The improvements made to our playground will ensure that our school grounds are appropriate for holding a range of sporting events;
