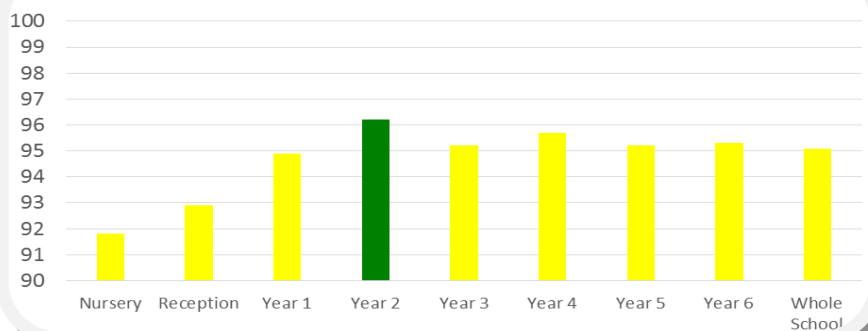

Our attendance up to the end of the spring term can be seen below.

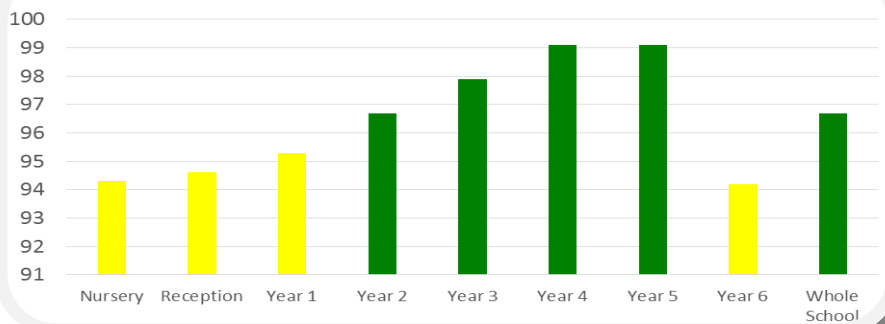

Whole School Attendance: 5th September 2017 - 29th March 2018



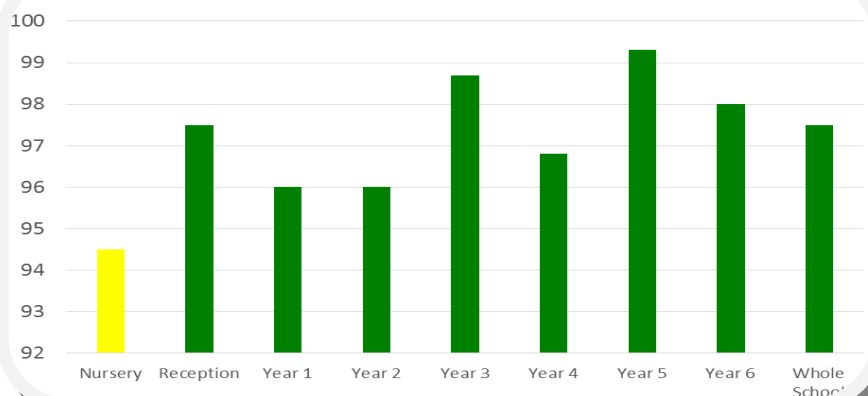
Our first week back has been positive with 4 out of 8 classes achieving 96% or above. Well done to Year 5, Year 4, Year 3 and Year 2.

Weekly Attendance: 16th - 19th April 2018



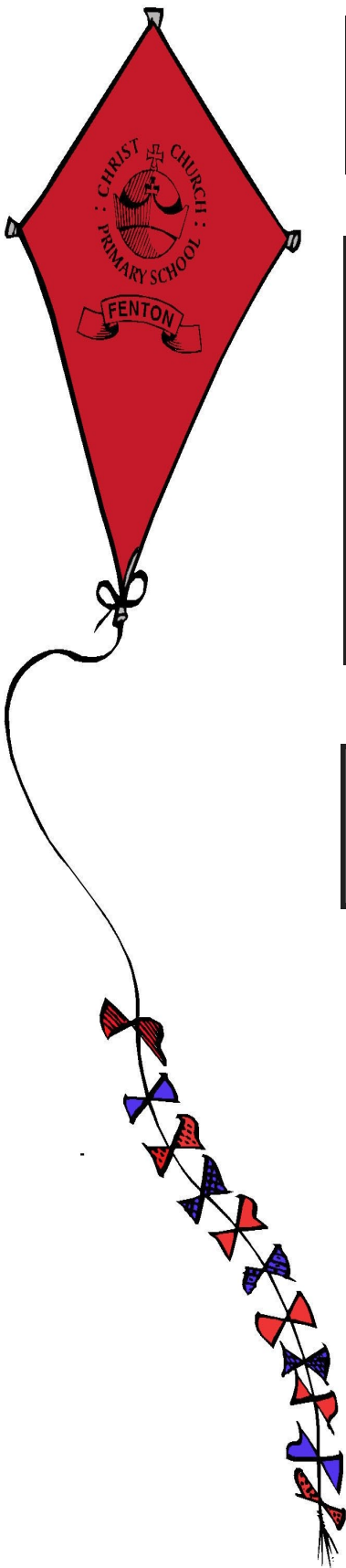
Our second week back has been even better with most classes achieving above 96%. Let's hope the excellent attendance continues.

**School Photographs**

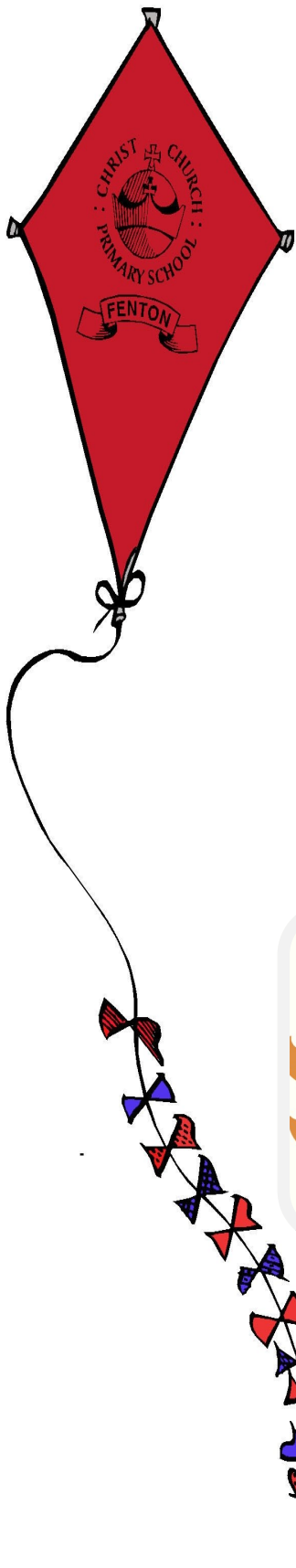
There is still time to order your child's class photo. If you would like to purchase any photographs, orders need to be returned to school by Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> May.

### School Meals

**Did you know that extra money comes into the school budget for each child who claims free school meals? Your child can still bring a packed lunch to school but the claim triggers extra funding for our school**

If you are on Income Support or income based Job Seekers Allowance your child is entitled to a free school meal. **THIS CAN BE CLAIMED BY CONTACTING THE SCHOOL OFFICE ON 234834.**

The Free School Meals Office at the Civic Centre is open throughout the main school holidays. The telephone number is 236813. If you have an older child already on free meals, you will still need to apply for the younger child.

*Please claim your free school meals if you think you may be entitled to them!*



### Sun Safety

To keep your child sunsafe at breaktime and lunchtime could you please encourage them to wear a hat outside during these times. Applying once a day suntan lotion before the children leave for school each morning would also mean that they are protected against the sun. This is particularly important for our nursery and reception pupils who spend more time each day outside than our older pupils.

### Scooters and Bicycles

As the mornings and afternoons are now lighter it is good to see children travelling to school using their bicycle or scooter. However, please remember that these should not be ridden on the playground before or after school to ensure that all pupils and parents are safe.

### Main Entrance

For health and safety reasons can we please ask parents and children not to wait in the main entrance before school. The office area isn't very big and does become congested in a morning especially when we have additional visitors.
