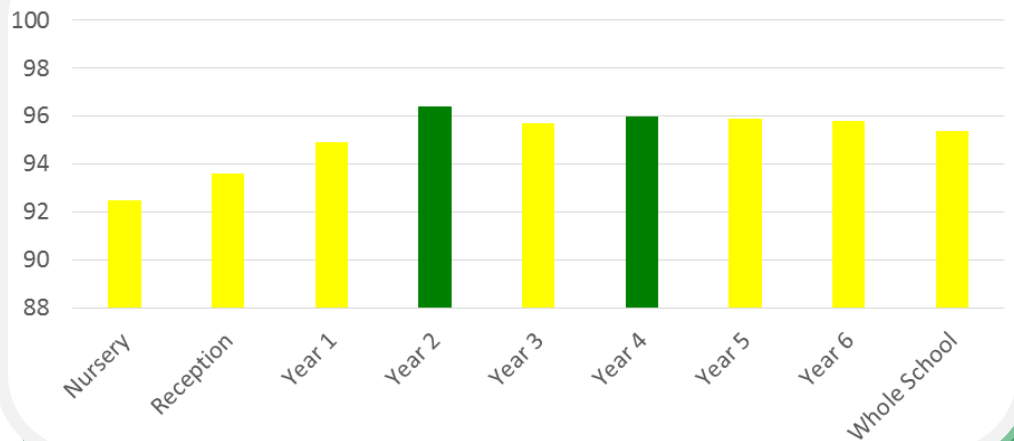

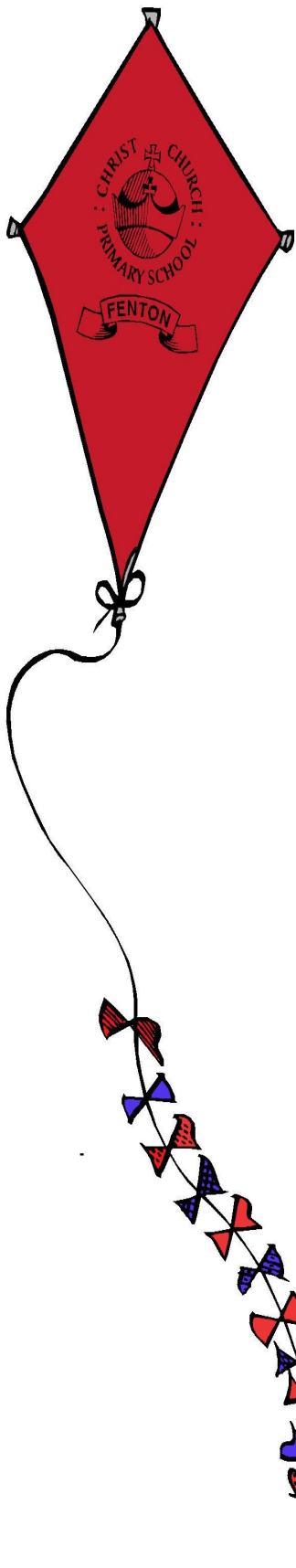


Non-Uniform Days to Support Summer Fayre/Bingo 29th June 2018

Sadly, our recently created early years play area and early years storage has been vandalised on a number of occasions since Easter. Parents have reported to us seeing past and present pupils on the school grounds after school hours and during the weekend. The police have been contacted and they have assured us that they will be stepping up patrols during the weekend and after school. We are also paying for security patrols to take place out of school hours and will be having external CCTV cameras fitted before the end of term. We are extremely disappointed that the damage has happened and will continue to work with the local police and security services to ensure that our school premises are protected.
