



<p>My Family</p> 	<p>Who is in your family? What other relatives do you have? How does your family link together? How many people do you have in your family?</p> <p>Create a piece of artwork entitled 'Family'. This could be a drawing, a painting, a sculpture.</p>
<p>The Area where I Live</p> 	<p>What type of houses are on your street? What type of house do you live in? What other buildings are close by? Find out about their local area, what different buildings does it have? What is the area where you live famous for? Have any famous people lived there? How old are some of those buildings? How have they changed over time? Use a map to locate different places. Look on Google Earth. Draw their own map of their local area.</p> <p>Choose a building they most admire in their local area. Make a model of that building using materials of their choice. (Playdough, junk modelling, lego etc.....) How well did they do? What would they do differently next time? What have they learnt?</p> <p>Think about what would improve their local area? What is their local area lacking? What spoils their local area? What could be done?</p>
<p>Animals</p> 	<p>Do you have any pets at home?</p> <p>Create a fact file about a deadly predator (lion, tiger, crocodile, shark, killer whale, komodo dragon, golden eagle, polar bear)</p> <p>Draw pictures of predators and label them with information you find out. Where does the predator live? Why does it live there? What does it eat? How does it capture its prey? What special qualities do these predators have? Make a set of top trump cards using the information you have found out.</p>
<p>Food</p> 	<p>What is a balanced diet? Find out about the 5 food groups. Make a poster about them Carbohydrates Protein Dairy Fruits and Vegetables Fats.</p> <p>Where does their food come from? Which foods come from the UK? What is fairtrade?</p> <p>As a family, design a healthy meal plan for the week.</p> <p>Discuss their favourite foods and why they enjoy them?</p> <p>Look at lunch around the world and investigate how differently people eat in other parts of the world. Find out what a vegetarian is? Vegan? Kosher food? Halal food?</p>

<p>Sport</p> 	<p>How many different types of sport can you think of? Write a sporting A-Z (different sports, famous sportspeople). How many famous sports competitions can you name? What can you find out about: The Olympics, The Tour de France, Wimbledon, The Superbowl, UEFA Champions League, Formula One, Women's Cricket World Cup, (choose one or can you think of a different sporting competition)</p> <p>Do you have a favourite sport? A favourite team?</p> <p>Who is your favourite sports person? Draw or paint a portrait of them or create a collage. Create a poster for a special sporting event.</p>
<p>The Environment</p> 	<p>What is the weather like around the world? Which countries are most likely to have a snowstorm, torrential rain, heatwaves etc..... Find out about natural disasters such as forest fires, earthquakes, tsunamis, floods, tornados etc..... How is climate change having an effect on the weather and natural disasters?</p> <p>Using recycled materials design and make a recycling mascot to spread the word about the importance and need to recycle. Think about what it is going to look like? Which materials are they going to use? How are they going to join the materials together? Once completed, remember to evaluate their mascot. What would they do differently next time? Which parts did they find the most challenging and why?</p> <p>What do you know about air pollution, climate change, litter, waste?</p>
<p>Music</p> 	<p>What types of music do you listen to? Do you have a favourite pop star or pop group? How many different musical instruments do you know? If you could play a musical instrument, which would, you like to play? Can you draw a picture of your favourite musical instrument, pop star or group? Can you remember the names of any famous composers? Maybe you could make a musical fact sheet with everything Mr Hall or Mr Farrington has taught you.</p>
<p>Celebrations</p> 	<p>How are birthdays celebrated around the world? India China America Africa etc. maybe there's a particular country you would like to find out about. Create fact files to show the similarities and differences between them.</p> <p>What else do people celebrate? Easter, Passover, Ramadan, May Day. Can you think of any other celebrations?</p>

Maybe you can think of your own learning projects.

- Do you have a special hobby that you want to tell your teacher about?
- Do you collect something unusual e.g. pebbles, badges, dolls, Trolls,?
- Do you have a favourite toy, TV programme, film or video game?
- Is there something that you really enjoy doing that you haven't told your teacher about that you want to share? Now is the time!
