



Home Learning at Christ Church CE Primary Academy

Dear Parents,

I hope you are all still safe and well. We are all really missing the children and hope that normal schooling will return soon. It has been wonderful though keeping up with the work and activities you have completed with your children on Class Dojo and Purple Mash.

As school is still currently closed, we are providing more learning activities to be completed at home. These are not worksheet based but provide the children with a choice of activities to allow them to practise skills they already have. A suggested timetable can be seen below which should still provide some free time for the children.

Suggested Timetable

Morning

- Aim to complete one piece of maths, reading, writing/spelling each morning (ideas below)
- Have some exercise with Joe Wicks or go outside where it is safe and play some games.

Afternoon

- In the afternoon work on one of the Learning Projects posted on our school website www.christchurchfenton.co.uk. There are a choice of 8 school ideas or you can choose your own project from the four suggestions underneath.

We have also included a list of websites and other activities which the children may want to look at linked to subjects like science, art, RE, music, geography, PE. These could be completed instead of any of the activities above. All of the sheets can also be accessed via our school website www.christchurchfnton.co.uk under the children's tab, Home Learning and Useful Websites.

We do realise that learning at home is very different to learning in school. So, if you feel that the children need a day playing outside in the garden, playing board games, building something from Lego, baking, gardening, drawing, singing, dancing or anything else creative that's fine. They are all valuable skills and lessons, which are as important as reading, writing, maths and spelling.
