- Monday 2nd November: SCHOOL CLOSED, Staff training day




Do you use Bobbles, Bizy Bodz or Albert House for before and after school care?


As we have staggered start and finish times in place can you please ensure that your child's before and after school provision are aware of any new start and finish times so that children arrive and are collected at the correct time.

Toast

Toast will be provided again for morning snack from Wednesday 2nd September. The cost is 15p per slice. Toast money MUST be paid weekly every Monday with the exact money as no change will be given. This needs to be brought to school in a clearly labelled envelope or plastic bag stating who the toast is for and how many slices a day.







School Uniform

As you will probably need to buy some new school uniform for your child during the summer holidays, here is a brief reminder:

- All children need to wear sensible black shoes trainers are not allowed.
- Grey shorts, trousers or skirts can be worn or a gingham dress in warmer weather.
- A white polo shirt with a school sweatshirt, red v-neck jumper or cardigan. Long hair needs to be tied back.
- Earrings, necklaces and bracelets are not allowed but it is okay to wear a watch.
- We do not allow tramlines shaved into hair.
- Make-up, including nail varnish and temporary tattoos (except after school discos and other events), is not allowed.

The best time to have ears pierced is at the beginning of the summer holidays so that it does not prevent children from taking part in P.E. and swimming lessons which are essential parts of the national curriculum. We will contact you if your child does not comply with our school uniform policy and your child will not receive the correct school uniform dojo.



Breakfast Club

Breakfast club will commence on Monday 14th September. Can you please inform us if you would like a place for your child each week so we know which children we are expecting. Breakfast club MUST be paid weekly every Monday with the exact money as no change will be given. This needs to be brought to school in a clearly labelled envelope or plastic bag stating who the child/children are.
