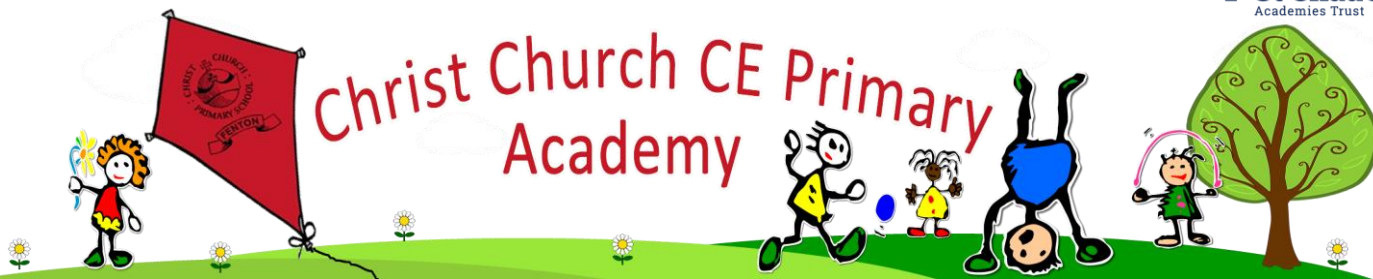


# Christ Church CE Primary Academy

## Nursery - Autumn Term 2020

Over this term we are learning about these amazing things:

We will be talking about what we look like, who is in our family and what our houses look like. We will learn that we are all different and that we are all special. We will listen to the story 'All in one Piece' and act it out using props. We will explore lots of activities that will challenge us in a creative way including drawing/ painting pictures of ourselves and our families, making models, and learning to recognise and write our names. In Mathematics we will be learning to recognise numerals to 5 and then 10 and match the numerals to quantity. We will also be looking at 2D shapes and patterns in the environment. We will learn rhymes, songs, poems and jingles and talk about rhyming words.
