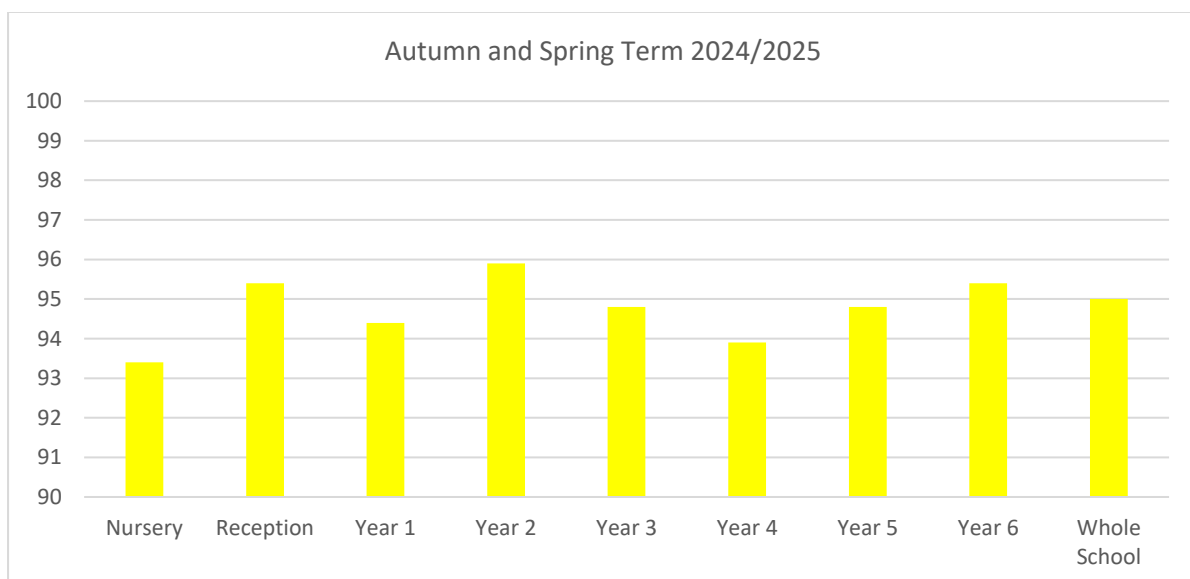
End of Spring Term 2025 Newsletter
